Lambeth Masjid offers Nikah (Islamic marriage) ceremonies conducted by our appointed Imams, in accordance with Shariah principles. Please note:

- This is a religious ceremony only and does NOT constitute a civil marriage under UK law.
- Couples are advised to register their marriage with their local council separately.

Ceremonies can be performed in English or Arabic at your preference. For bookings, please contact us well in advance.

Requirements:

- Valid Passport or UK Driving Licence for bride and groom
- Proof of address for both parties
- Presence of two Muslim male witnesses with ID
- Presence of the Wali (guardian) for the bride
- Written declaration of agreed Dowry (Mahr)
- £150 fee payable upon booking; £300 if ceremony is held off-site

Nikah Ceremony Overview

The Imam will:

- Seek verbal consent from both parties.
- Confirm agreement from the Wali (bride’s guardian).
- Discuss and document the Dowry (Mahr).
- Deliver a brief sermon on the importance of marriage in Islam.
- Announce and formalise the Nikah.

Please ensure all attendees observe Islamic etiquette and modest dress code.
